***RESOLUTION 2016-32:**

RESOLUTION TO VACATE A COUNTY ROAD
Hamilton County
Resolution No. 2016-32

WHEREAS, This being the date and time set for the hearing on the proposed vacation and closure of a portion of Hamilton County Secondary Road, described as follows:

That portion of 297th Street, originally established as part of Squaw Fork & Boone River Road on October 17, 1865 (See Road Record Book 1, pages 184-186) and modified in 1972, all lying in the SW ¼ of Section 11, T87N R26W of Hamilton County, Iowa. The intention of this road closure is to vacate the entire segment of public road (original and with modifications) commencing near the center of the SW ¼ of Section 11 and thence running approximately 1,050ft in an easterly direction to a point 55ft west of the centerline of Tunnel Mill Road (the west right-of-way line of Tunnel Mill Road). Furthermore, the intention is to vacate the aforementioned portion of 297th Street to the extent on the west end at which an adjoining section (running in a northerly direction) was previously vacated in 1974 (See Board of Supervisors Minutes, Book 15, pg 405).

WHEREAS, No objections have been received, either in writing or by persons present, and

WHEREAS, No claims for damages were received.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hamilton County Board of Supervisors that the subject section of road be ordered vacated and closed.
