The Hamilton County Secondary Roads Department will be accepting applications for an Engineering Technician – CAD until noon, Friday, August 31, 2018, at the Hamilton County Engineer's Office, Hamilton County Courthouse, 2300 Superior Street, Suite #4, Webster City, IA 50595.

Applicants must be able to apply a general knowledge of civil engineering principles and practices to assist in the planning, surveying, design, drafting, inspection, and administration of county contract and maintenance road and bridge projects. Applicants must also demonstrate strong public relations, communication, organizational, supervisory, and leadership skills and possess a standard high school degree or GED. Completion of an accredited Engineering Technician program is preferred but not required. Applicants should be able to use AutoCAD, Softtree, or other civil software and Microsoft Word and Excel software. Applicants must possess a valid Iowa driver's license.

Applicants will be subject to a pre-employment physical examination, including drug testing.
